### **American Public Gas Association**

- ~1000 community-owned gas systems
- Over 700 are APGA members
  - 37 states
  - ➤ ~5 Million Customers
  - >~21,000 Employees
  - ➤ ~120,000 Miles of Main
- Systems size: 38 to ~500,000 meters
- Largest: Philadelphia with ~ 500,000 meters
- Smallest: Freedom, OK with 38 meters



### **DOE Furnace Efficiency NOPR**



- DOE issued a direct final rule banning the use of noncondensing furnaces
- Condensing furnaces require special venting that may be impossible in many townhouses and other homes
- DOE rejected written comments raising substantive objections -- APGA sued
- DOE re-issued the NOPR to include all 50 states
- DOE relies proprietary reports and data not available to the public
- Fuel switching from the rule would result in increased energy consumption and higher costs to consumers

The Voice and Choice of Public Gas

#### SOAR Program the voice and choice of public gas



- SOAR = System Operations Achievement Recognition
- Give recognition to those APGA members that have demonstrated a culture of operational excellence
- Every APGA member can earn the recognition, if they meet the criteria





- Operational excellence is measured in 4 areas:
  - -System Integrity
  - -Employee Safety
  - -Workforce Development
  - -System Improvement




#### Example: System Integrity the voice and choice of public gas

- Criteria include:
  - Internal audits of its pipeline safety program,
  - Review of any probable violations in its last state inspection
  - Upper management involvement in safety decisions
  - Unaccounted for gas (< 1% for full points)
  - Participation in CGA's DIRT program
  - Participation in the plastic pipe data collection project
  - And 20 more areas








### Size of US Gas Distribution Systems
