
























NAPSR Committees

Grant Funding for States

- Many states participate in PHMSA's grant programs
- Up to 80% funding of pipeline safety programs for
 - ✓Natural Gas
 - ✓ Hazardous Liquid
 - ✓ Underground Storage
 - ✓ Damage Prevention
- Grant Guidelines / Reporting / Evaluations



The role of states

- Education (operators, public, & government officials)
- Inspection of companies for compliance
- Enforcement to address non-compliances
- Investigation accidents & incidents
 - ✓ People
 - ✓ Property
 - ✓ Environment
- Each state differs!

What do inspections look like?

- Inspection serve as way to ensure compliance with regulations.
- Review of:
 - ✓ Plans
 - ✓ Procedures
 - ✓ Training/Qualifications
 - ✓ Piping and facilities



2021 Inspection Stats

- Full time inspectors are required to accrue 85 inspection-days each year...
- States accrued 54,494 (642 FTE) inspection days in 2021

Investigations

- Pipeline investigation in follow up to regulatory requirements
- Elements of the investigation
 - ✓ Is the operator making the area safe?
 - ✓ What happened and why did it happen?
 - ✓ How can this be prevented from happening again?
