The fastest way to initiate the emergency response system is 911!

As soon as a problem is identified, let the emergency responders know. We would rather discover nothing than discover a catastrophic release that may endanger the community and responders!!

- Provide contact information to the 911 Operator! We need to talk!
- The Incident Commander will have several questions! Our Response Priorities are always:
 Life Safety-this includes First Responders!
 - Incident Stabilization
 - Property Conservation
 - Environmental Concerns

Life Safety-What does this actually mean?

Initial arriving responders will make a risk assessment based upon:

■ Experience-(RPDM)

Level of Training

Resources Available

Populated urban areas will typically have more resources to draw upon, however the population is typically more vulnerable!

Incident Stabilization

- The earlier we make contact with the "Operator" the better decisions we can make to begin the stabilization process!
- Early identification of the product is a key piece of information
- Resource capability of the "Operator" and response time of those resources is vital!

Property Conservation

We will protect exposures within acceptable risk as assessed by the Incident Commander

Most community's Emergency Response Plans are based upon two decisions:

Shelter in Place

■ Evacuation

Environmental Concerns

- Most Fire Departments whether municipal or rural have very few resources for environmental remediation
- We will rely heavily upon the "Operators" for environmental issues
 - Environmental Contractors
 - Capabilities
 - Resources
 - Training
